Waterfall Walk for Saturday 27 May 2017

Arrival time 10am - Approximate journey time 1hr 45mins - Walk starts 10.30am

Directions to start of Walk.

M4 west (Cardiff), bridge fee £6.70.

At **Junction 32**, follow **A470**, signed for **Merthyr Tydfil**. Dual carriageway all the way.

Merthyr Tydfil has four roundabouts on the dual carriage way, the third one has a MacDonalds sign visible (RHS), so it's the next one you want. At the fourth **roundabout**, **turn right** onto **A465** to **Hirwaun** and Penwaun.

At next **roundabout** (Penwaun) turn right staying on **A465**. At next **roundabout** (Hirwaun) go straight on. The **A465 to Neath** becomes dual carriage way.

The dual carriageway goes around a long left hand bend and continues downhill. Near the bottom of the hill look out for a turning left **A4109** signed Dan yr Ogof Caves.

Turn left off dual carriageway, **A4109**, which goes under the road, across the river to traffic lights.

At traffic lights turn right, (sign posted Waterfalls) not long after turn left, sign posted to Waterfalls Centre (Canolfan y Sgydau) **B4242 to** Pontneddfechan.

The road follows the river. Look out for **The Angel pub** (**SA11 5NR**, 01639 722013) on the left, it is next to the small car park and toilets. **There are no toilets at the start of the walk**.

Continue along the road, taking the left hand fork (signed to Ystradfellte) (*) up a steep hill and then round a hair pin bend. Leaving the village, you will pass the Glyn Neath golf club. Continue along the lane for approximately 3.5km. Just before the second cattle grid you will find a parking area on the rhs of the road, next to an entrance for Clyn-gwyn bunk house (SA11 5US). You have arrived at the start of the walk.

(*) The left hand fork in the road, bedside the pub, leads to the Tea shop, Gunpowder walk and across the bridge to Craig y Ddinas Car park (free)- where the walk ends. A good place to meet up afterwards.

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
